

Statement by the sponsor ("forlover")

Please send the form to Skatteetaten (The Norwegian Tax Administration)

The couple to be married must each have a sponsor, who must sign a sponsor declaration. The sponsor must be at least 18 years old, and must know the person they are sponsoring well. The sponsor signing the declaration and the witness present for the marriage ceremony do not have to be the same person. The declaration is part of the documentation requirement for verification of the conditions for marriage.
